



The MQH Outreach and Social Action Committee requests your support for Evergreen Shared Housing for Women



Evergreen provides safe and supportive sober living for women in recovery from substance use disorders. Evergreen was founded and operated by a parishioner of MQH Parish. Evergreen has already helped 8 women come through the house and become independent and successful on their own. Your financial contributions are critical to help continue this mission of hope and healing.

Evergreen hopes this July Drive will help fund a secure software program to track resident progress, maintain intake records, and ensure compliance recovery goals and house policies. Following the program is critical for recovery. Funds are also needed to restock household essentials, provide hygiene kits for residents arriving with limited personal belongings, replace worn mattresses, provide clean bedding and towels.

We ask for your monetary donations in a second collection next weekend, July 5th & 6th. Checks should be made payable to Mary Queen of Heaven Parish. Mary Queen will transmit all collected funds to Evergreen.

Evergreen has expressed their gratitude for your support of the April drive. Your donations provided transportation for two residents to job interviews, work commutes, recovery meetings, and health services. Some residents come to Evergreen with almost nothing unable to provide their own transportation. Funds were also used for a vegetable and herb garden to promote wellness, self-sufficiency and healing though nature. A small portion was used to start a reserve fund for future unexpected expenses and continued operation.

We cannot thank those contributing to the Giving Weekends enough. We are making a difference!
