A MESSAGE FROM FATHER SŁAWEK



Praise be Jesus Christ... Now and Forever!

This weekend we celebrate the Third Sunday of Advent, traditionally known as Gaudete Sunday. The name comes from the Latin word Gaudete, meaning rejoice. In the midst of Advent's quieter, penitential preparation, the Church invites us to step back and remember that the Lord is near. The rose candle on the Advent wreath and rose vestments at Mass are joyful signs that the dawn of Christ's coming is breaking through the darkness.

Advent is a season of hope, but it is also a season that asks something of us. We prepare our homes for Christmas, but even more, we prepare our hearts. Today's readings remind us that joy is not something shallow or sentimental. Christian joy springs from the deep conviction that God is faithful, God keeps His promises, and God enters into our lives in unexpected ways.

In the First Reading, the prophet Isaiah speaks words that lift up the weary: "Strengthen the hands that are feeble... Say to those whose hearts are frightened: Be strong, fear not!" Isaiah reminds us that God's presence transforms deserts into gardens and sorrow into gladness. When we invite God into the "dry places" of our lives, we begin to see new life grow.

The Gospel shows John the Baptist pointing away from himself and toward Christ. Even from prison, John remains faithful to his mission. He sends his disciples to Jesus, and the Lord responds by revealing His works: the blind see, the lame walk, and the poor hear the Good News. Jesus is telling John—and us—that the Kingdom is already among us, even if we cannot fully see it yet.

Gaudete Sunday also invites us to ask a simple question: Where is God inviting me to find joy right now? Joy is not the absence of difficulties. It is the presence of Christ in every circumstance. Sometimes joy appears in small, quiet ways—a kind word, a moment of prayer, a simple act of charity. When we slow down long enough to notice, we discover signs of God's grace all around us.

This week, let us take time to practice gratitude. Even amid busy schedules and heavy responsibilities, naming our blessings renews our hearts. Advent joy grows when we recognize what God has already done for us and trust in what He is still doing. As we move closer to Christmas, may we cultivate a spirit that is patient, hopeful, and ready to welcome the Lord.

As we light the rose candle on our Advent wreaths, may it remind us that Christ is near. Let us open our hearts to His healing presence and share His joy with those around us—especially those who feel tired, anxious, or alone during this season. May this Gaudete Sunday strengthen our parish family and prepare us to receive Christ with renewed faith and gladness.
