

Honoring the Dedication of Mimi Nolan and Mary Ann Reed

This week, our parish community at Mary Queen of Heaven offers heartfelt gratitude to two remarkable women whose faith and service have blessed our parish for many years — Mimi Nolan and Mary Ann Reed. Their devotion, compassion, and leadership have touched countless lives and strengthened the spiritual life of our community.

Mimi Nolan

Mimi became involved in volunteering at Mary Queen of Heaven soon after joining the parish in 2001. She began her service in the RCIA program as a Faith Companion, which led her to become a Eucharistic Minister and Lector. Her deep commitment to faith and community soon brought her additional responsibilities as she was asked to coordinate both the RCIA and Bereavement Committees, while also beginning her work in the Ministry of Care.

In 2008, Mimi became a Pastoral Associate for the parish, working closely with Fr. Tony. After three years of dedicated service in that role, she stepped back from administrative duties but continued her ministry in RCIA and, alongside Deacon Tom, in the Ministry of Care. After retiring from outside employment, she dedicated even more of her time and heart to the parish community. Mimi has been faithfully devoted to the Ministry of Care for over 15 years, ensuring that the sick and homebound received not only the Eucharist but also compassion and presence.

Over the years, Mimi has worked with six pastors at Mary Queen of Heaven, always with grace, faith, and humility. Her tireless contributions to the well-being of so many parishioners reflect her deep love for God and His people. In recognition of her outstanding service, Mimi was honored as Woman of the Year — not once, but twice.

Mary Ann Reed

Mary Ann and her family joined Mary Queen of Heaven in 1997, and from the beginning, she felt a calling to serve wherever she was needed. Her generous spirit led her to participate in many parish ministries, including CHIRP, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Parish Council, Adult Education, Peace and Justice, and the Anti-Racism Project. Her faith in action has been a blessing to our entire community.

In 2015, while attending a funeral at Mary Queen of Heaven, Mary Ann was deeply moved by the compassion shown to a grieving family. That experience became a turning point—she recognized God's call to serve in the Bereavement Ministry. Having recently retired, she felt ready to dedicate herself fully to this ministry of care. After several months of working and shadowing with Mimi, she accepted the role of Minister of Bereavement.

For the next 10 years, Mary Ann faithfully accompanied families in their time of loss, helping them prepare meaningful funeral liturgies and offering comfort rooted in faith. Her presence brought peace and consolation to so many during moments of sorrow. In recognition of her faith-filled leadership and compassionate service, Mary Ann was named Woman of the Year in 2024.

Both Mimi and Mary Ann have given beautiful witness to what it means to live out one's faith in service to others. Their ministries — though different in focus — share the same heart: a desire to bring Christ's love, hope, and comfort to all. Their dedication has strengthened our parish family and inspired many others to serve.

As they conclude their time in these ministries, we offer Mimi Nolan and Mary Ann Reed our deepest gratitude and prayers. May God bless them abundantly for all they have done in His name, and may they continue to find joy and peace knowing how profoundly their work has touched the lives of others.

To celebrate their years of faithful service, there will be a reception after the 10:00 a.m. Mass this Sunday in honor of Mimi Nolan and Mary Ann Reed. Please join us to express your gratitude and share in thanksgiving for all they have done for Mary Queen of Heaven Parish.

There is a SignUp Genius link located on the homepage of the Mary Queen website (mqhelmhurst.org) titled "Volunteer SignUp - Senior Christmas Dinner sponsored by CCW, Preschool, Faith Formation". Food is to be dropped off between 4:00-5:00PM in Barrett Hall. Please have your hot food hot, and the cold food cold already. Disposable trays are great. Otherwise mark any dishes that you will collect after the dinner with your name, with masking tape and permanent marker. You can pick these up at your convenience, after the dinner. Each dish should serve 8 to 10 adults please. Dishes generally needed can be ham, meatballs, chicken casseroles, green lettuce sales, coleslaw, jello salads, pasta salads, rice, casseroles, or baked pasta. Also sweet potato, zucchini, carrot, asparagus or green bean dishes; corn or potato casserole, or mashed potatoes.

Set up will be late morning; welcoming from 4:30-6:30PM. The other shifts are welcoming, serving, drinks and clean-up from 5:30-7:30PM; or clean-up from 7:00-8:30PM.




FAITH FORMATION NEWS - MARY GLAUDELL, DIRECTOR
