



The Mary Queen of Heaven (MQOH) Parish Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA) Program is to start **Sunday, September 7, 2025**.

The OCIA Program is open for adults, high school age and over, who wish to enter into the Catholic Church by receiving the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist.

It is also open to any Catholic, or anyone who has already been baptized in the Christian Faith and makes a Profession of Faith to Catholicism, who wishes to celebrate the Sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.

Though these sessions are primarily for the Catechumen / Candidates, any parishioners who wish to enhance / share their Faith experience(s) are welcome to sit-in.

The schedule has been set for Sunday mornings – (one-hour sessions) starting at 11:00 am in Room 13. The program runs from mid-September through to the Sacraments being celebrated at the Easter Vigil or at the Cathedral of St. Raymond in Joliet, as applicable, to its conclusion around Pentecost Sunday 2025.

Hello, I am here to talk to you about the preschool.

The parish, which is all of you, have always been so supportive of the school since day I back in 2007; thankfully that has not changed. I felt that you would like an update about the school.

There are some changes in the way the Diocese of Joliet and the State of Illinois will govern their schools. The biggest change for the preschool is now we are titled a "stand alone" school which we always were because we do not have an Elementary school. Due to this title standing we are required to have a DCFS license for just our preschool. We are still part of the Diocese of Joliet Catholic Schools and they are helping us through this process.

Change is inevitable but change is not always easy, smooth, or quick. We are still in the process of getting our application approved.

I am telling you this because you might be wondering why there is less activity at the school. We won't start preschool until our application is approved. Unfortunately, this could be another month or so.

Please keep us in your prayers and I will keep you updated through our article in the bulletin.
