

### A MESSAGE FROM FATHER SŁAWEK

### Praise be Jesus Christ... Now and Forever!

This Sunday we celebrate World Mission Sunday, a day when the whole Church joins in prayer and solidarity for the missionary work of spreading the Gospel. Every baptized person is a missionary disciple—called to witness the love of Christ to others through prayer, word, and action. Mission is not something far away; it begins in the heart of each believer.

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus tells the story of a widow who never gives up asking for justice. Her persistence moves even an unjust judge to act. Jesus uses this parable to teach us the power of persevering prayer. If a dishonest judge can respond to persistence, how much more will our loving and merciful God listen to those who cry out to Him day and night? God always hears the prayers of His people, even when His answer may come slowly or in ways we do not expect.

This Gospel invites us to trust that faithful prayer changes hearts—our own hearts first, and often the hearts of others as well. Mission begins with prayer. Before we can speak about Jesus, we must first speak with Him. The missionary spirit grows in silence, trust, and daily perseverance in prayer, even when the world seems indifferent or hostile to faith.

On this Mission Sunday, we are reminded that prayer must always lead to action. To be missionary is to make God's mercy visible through our deeds of love, compassion, and justice. Some are called to go to distant lands, but most of us are called to live the Gospel right where we are—at home, at work, in our parish, and in our neighborhoods. Every act of kindness and forgiveness is a small mission that brings the light of Christ to

I would like to thank all those who have supported my mission outreach in Kenya. Through your prayers and generosity, you have helped bring hope and dignity to children and women in need. Your support builds not only classrooms and kitchens but also a community of faith that reflects the Gospel's compassion and joy. You are living witnesses of what it means to be missionaries of Christ's love.

Let us continue to pray for all missionaries throughout the world—priests, sisters, brothers, and lay people—who often serve in difficult and dangerous conditions. May God strengthen them with courage and perseverance, and may their example inspire us to be faithful witnesses wherever we are.

May this Mission Sunday renew in each of us a missionary heart—a heart that prays without ceasing, loves without limits, and trusts that God's justice and mercy will prevail. Let us never lose heart, but keep faith alive through prayer and good works, until the day the Son of Man finds faith burning brightly on the earth.


