

THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

Solemnity of the Assumption of The Blessed Virgin Mary is Friday, August 15th. This solemnity commemorates Mary being assumed body and soul into heaven at the end of her earthly life. The date was formally confirmed in the 9th century by Pope Leo IV, who helped solidify its celebration throughout the universal Church. In the United States and many other countries, it is a holy day of obligation, meaning Catholics are required to participate in Mass.






