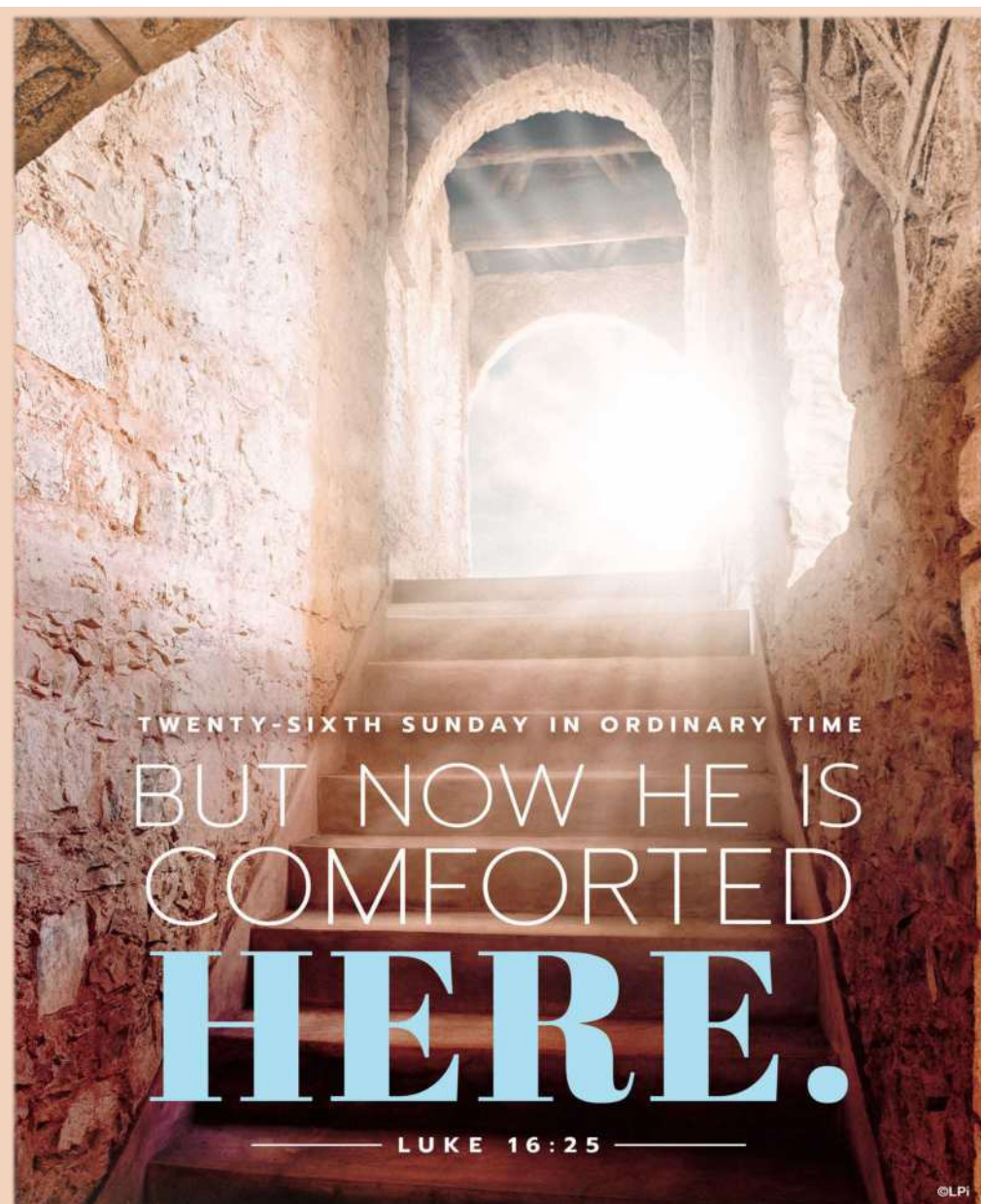

A MESSAGE FROM FATHER SŁAWEK

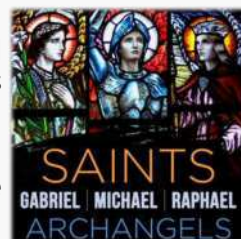
Praise be Jesus Christ... Now and Forever!

From Monday, September 15th, through Thursday, September 18th, the priests of the Diocese of Joliet gathered with Bishop Ronald Hicks for the annual diocesan convocation. The meeting was held in Oak Brook and provided a valuable opportunity for prayer, reflection, and fraternity among the clergy of our diocese.

A highlight of this year's convocation was the introduction of Bishop Hicks's first pastoral letter. Entitled MAKE, this document reflects the Bishop's vision for renewing and strengthening the life of faith in our parishes and communities.

In his letter, Bishop Hicks calls upon all the faithful to live out the Gospel by "making disciples," "making time for prayer," "making peace," and "making Christ known" through our words and actions. The pastoral letter will be formally presented to the people of the Diocese on Tuesday, September 30th, and will serve as an important guide for our common mission.

This week, the Church invites us to celebrate several significant feast days. On Monday, we honor the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael—heavenly spirits who serve as God's messengers and protectors of His people.



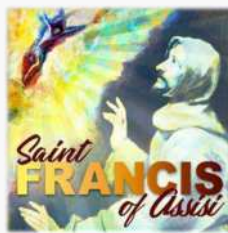
On Wednesday, October 1st, we commemorate Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus, affectionately known as "The Little Flower." Saint Thérèse is remembered for her "little way" of love and trust in God, a simple yet profound path to holiness that continues to inspire the faithful around the world.



Thursday brings the Memorial of the Holy Guardian Angels. This feast reminds us of God's loving providence in entrusting to each of us a guardian angel to guide, protect, and intercede for us throughout our lives.



On Saturday, October 4th, the Church celebrates the Memorial of Saint Francis of Assisi. Saint Francis is revered for his humility, his care for creation, and his dedication to living the Gospel in simplicity and peace. His example continues to call us to a deeper love for God, for one another, and for the world entrusted to our care.



In honor of Saint Francis, our parish will hold the traditional Blessing of Pets on Sunday, October 5th, at 1:00 PM. All parishioners and friends are warmly invited to bring their pets for this blessing, as together we give thanks for the beauty of creation and the companionship of the animals who share our lives.

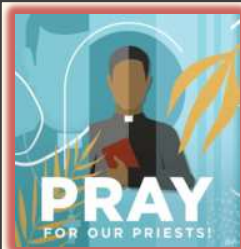

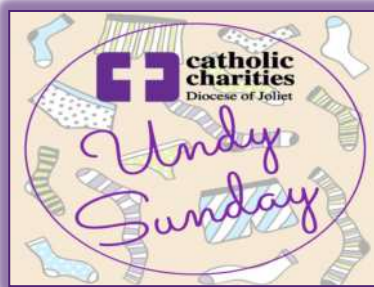

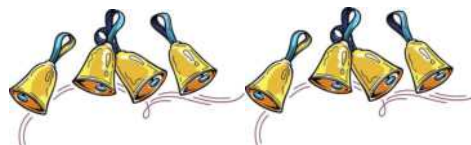


READY TO RING? JOIN OUR NEW HANDBELL CHOIR
