A Message from Fr. Sunny

Thirteen Sundays...

Last weekend, I made an announcement in church that the Bishop has called me to be re-assigned to Saint Michael Parish in Wheaton by the next fiscal year, that is July 1, 2024. As customary, the moving day of priests is on the last Wednesday of June. This weekend, I am counting that we have thirteen Sundays to share with each other in our usual weekend liturgy, and I want to make the most of them. I was very moved by the many reactions of people about the announcement, and I appreciate the messages of appreciation, support and gratitude.

This weekend, the first of the last thirteen, is Palm Sunday. Jesus entered Jerusalem in style, triumphantly, with a welcome fit for a king or a celebrity of the city of David. Until today, that triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem is marked as one of the most important Christian celebrations in the Holy Land. Starting from the foot of the Mount of Olives, by the St. Stephen Church, people would still be carrying big palm branches and with songs of praise and hosanna's in various languages and prayers mixed with chattering sounds from rowdy crowds and tourists, the procession goes all the way to the church of the Holy Sepulcher in the Christian Quarter of the Old City of Jerusalem. While I have never been there on that exact day, I have seen enough videos to be able to imagine what that might be like in real life, and I can only imagine it to be crazy exuberant for every Christian. This day marks the beginning of the holiest week in the Christian calendar, one that culminates in the celebration of the triduum – Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday which begins with the solemn Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday! The complete program of events is available in our bulletin, social media and official website.

My dear Church, please don't ignore this week. Observe it well, keep it holy, and take the privilege with all your heart. There are so many beautiful things that happen during this season, and let us appreciate it all with devotion and reverent disposition.

Together with the most important triduum services, I also invite you to make the most of the services of Holy Tuesday, where our own parishioners will share their reflections on the Seven Last Words of Jesus Christ on the Cross. This will be our third year of doing this activity, as well as the Tenebrae Service (Service of Shadows) on Holy Wednesday. Both events will be held at seven o'clock in the evening.

This Holy Week is especially meaningful for me because this is my last Holy Week with you all. I have truly savored all the previous Lenten days and holy weeks here at Mary Queen, and I hope that this last one with you will be equally joyful, meaningful and unforgettable. Let us pray together that we may have the ability and opportunity to give God due praise for the many heavenly favors and blessings we receive from God every day, but most especially the gift of new life and salvation won for us by our Good Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Have a blessed Holy Week, my dear church. And may God's love be with you always.
