A Message from Fr. Sunny

IN THE MIDST OF A JOURNEY

I have been doing pilgrimages since 2006, barely two years after my ordination. I started to think about it when I read an article from Pope Benedict encouraging the faithful to visit the holy shrines of the Catholic Church for their spiritual growth. It is also something that Pope John Paul II was known for, being the most traveled pope in history.

Seventeen years later, I am here in the Philippines doing my twentieth pilgrimage together with my friends Frs. Mario Quejadas and Dindo Billote, and twenty-two others who are visiting some of the Philippines' most sacred shrines in Bohol and Cebu, plus a short visit to Coron, Palawan for sight-seeing and relaxation. It is my first time to visit these churches and shrines. It is also my first time to attend the well-known festival called Sinulog, which pays homage to the statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague that was gifted by the Spaniards to the chieftain of Cebu, who was baptized with his family into Catholicism, marking the beginning of Christianity in the country. I am excited and thankful for this trip because it is an opportunity for me to get to know the land of my birth better than ever before.

As a Catholic priest, I have grown so much in my knowledge and appreciation of the Catholic Church through traveling and visiting Catholic shrines. I was also able to have many profound spiritual experiences during these travels. They have helped mold my spirituality and awakened me to the true universality of the Church. Here are ten of the most unforgettable moments:

- 1. Celebrating masses in Bethlehem, Nazareth, Golgotha, Gethsemane.
- 2. Kissing the spot where Jesus was born.
- 3. Receiving a blessing from Pope John Paul II, when he put his hand on my head in the Vatican, and later on receiving a rosary from him in a private audience.
- 4. Experiencing a healing miracle in Lourdes, France.
- 5. Sailing on the Sea of Galilee, feeling the presence of Jesus walking on the water.
- 6. Walking through the ruins of Ephesus, thinking that Saint Paul walked right on those actual spots.
- 7. Being with my mother in three pilgrimages so far: Holy land, Marian (Fatima to Lourdes) and Central Europe (Poland, Austria, Hungary, Czech Republic, Slovakia).
- 8. Celebrating Mass at the Chapel of the Apparition in Fatima.
- 9. Singing songs to the Virgin Mary in procession to see the tilma at the Guadalupe Shrine in Mexico.
- 10. Witnessing conversion and spiritual renewal among the pilgrims.

On September 30, 2024, I am going to another Marian Pilgrimage to visit the shrines of Lisbon, Fatima, Lourdes, Spain, Montserrat and Barcelona. This is an amazingly beautiful and spiritually charged journey. All are welcome. Meanwhile, as I continue this spiritual journey here in my beloved Philippines, know that you are prayed for, my dear MQH family. God bless you.
