

# A Message from Fr. Sunny

# PREPARE THE WAY OF JESUS:

# Healing and Renewal through Holy Confession

During the Advent Season, we hear one of the most important prophetic messages of all time: BE PREPARED! Prepare, for at an hour you don't know the Son of Man will come (Matthew 24:44). Prepare, because the end will come like a thief in the night (1 Thessalonians 5:2). Prepare because Jesus will come again in His glory!

If an angel of God suddenly blows a trumpet into the earth and announces that there is just one hour left before the parousia, (the Second Coming at end of the world), will you be prepared? Will you panic and discontinue what you are doing and run to the closest church? A saint said, "I will go on ahead with my day's plans... Jesus is my Lord and Saviour. This weekend, as we light the second candle of the advent wreath, we acknowledge the great depth of insight to prepare for Jesus.

Preparing the way of Jesus is a call to self-examination and to give God's mercy a chance to renew and reform us back into His image, which becomes distorted because of sin. How good Jesus is that He commissioned His apostles to be instruments of divine forgiveness. How convenient and accessible Jesus has made His divine mercy through the confession of sins in church. That is why I am always puzzled why many people wait so long to go to the sacrament of reconciliation and even many years to return to it. In the previous years, when the priests of our deanery would offer the Deanery Advent Reconciliation, I would hear confessions of people who have never been to confession for as long as ten years or twenty years. Over the years, I remember hearing the confession of someone whose previous confession was sixty-one years ago. I pray that this year, especially because our Deanery Advent Confessions will be held here at Mary Queen of Heaven on December 16, from 9:00 in the morning to 3:00 in the afternoon, our parishioners will take advantage of the grace that the sacrament of forgiveness offers. There is no better way to prepare for the coming of Jesus.

Let me finish this article with a prayer written by the great 18th Century Saint Alphonsus Liguori, one of the doctors of the Church:

O my God, help me to make a good confession. Mary, my dearest Mother, pray to Jesus for me. Help me to examine my conscience, enable me to obtain true sorrow for my sins, and beg for me the grace rather to die than to offend God again. Lord Jesus, light of our souls, who enlightens every man coming into this world, enlighten my conscience and my heart by Thy Holy Spirit, so that I may perceive all that is displeasing to Thy divine majesty and may expiate it by humble confession, true contrition, and sincere repentance. Amen.

On Monday, December 11, 2023, the diocese will celebrate the Opening Liturgy for the 75th Anniversary at the Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus. Ten bishops are expected to be in attendance for this special liturgy, which will begin with 5:15 p.m. performances by three choirs (Vietnamese, Polish and African American) ahead of the 6 p.m. Mass. The universal prayers will be read in seven languages, and a custom 75th Anniversary Psalm and Prayer will be incorporated into the liturgy. The Mass will be livestreamed starting at 5:15 p.m. from the Diocese of Joliet's YouTube channel.
