## **VOCATIONS WEEK**

When we were born, God already had a plan for us. God had a purpose. God had a vision of what He wanted us to be. That Divine plan, purpose, and vision is our vocation. From the word "vocare", which means "to call," we celebrate Vocations Sunday to celebrate what God has intended for us, our calling that God wanted us to respond to.

WHAT IS YOUR CALLING? Every human being is called to be holy, that is our universal vocation. We do this by conforming our will with God's will. We are sanctified when we cooperate with the workings of the Holy Spirit in our lives. The Holy Spirit guides us to the fulfillment of our vocation.

DO YOU WANT TO ANSWER GOD'S CALL? OF COURSE! There has to be no better way than God's way. It is a no-brainer to want to do what God wants. Our Divine Purpose is envisioned by God at the beginning of our life, but such is a gift, a proposition to our human freedom. In the end, God who is all powerful is not going to insist His plan if we do not desire it. How incredible to think of such a loving God who respects our freedom. Whatever choice we make, beyond His original plan, God can fully adjust and pave the way to a meaningful life, by infusing grace within the environment of our own choices. Just like a GPS, God has the power and knowledge to be able to "recalculate" a different path for us, one that can still lead to a meaningful and abundant, holy life. At the same time, God will also hold us responsible, and maybe even accountable.

LET US PRAY THAT WE MAY ALL RESPOND TO GOD'S CALL. This weekend is Vocations Sunday. Let us pray together that as God has called many to serve Him and His Church. So many will indeed hear the call and respond well and generously. The three vocations are: marriage, single blessedness, and consecrated life. If we all live as we have been called, there would not be a crisis in the family, in the priestly vocation and in lay ministry. Here at Mary Queen, let us encourage one another to live our vocations well. Let us also guide our youth to discern well what God wants them to do with their lives. I encourage you to have a lively conversation with your family about the Will of God and God's call. I also ask you to pray for vocations to the priesthood, religious life, diaconate and lay ministry.

And perhaps, we can pray together the radically beautiful Sucipe Prayer, attributed to St. Ignatius of Loyola: "Take Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all that I have and possess. Thou hast given all to me. To Thee, O lord, I return it. All is Thine, dispose of it wholly according to Thy will. Give me Thy love and thy grace, for this is sufficient for me. Amen."
