



A Message from Fr. Sunny

Fall in Love with God

In last Sunday's bulletin, I encouraged you, my dear MQH parishioners, to never stop learning about your faith, i.e., to get to know more about God and His Church takes more than a lifetime to really know. In fact, we never really fully exhaust the truth about God and His Church. The ongoing quest to discover God and the richness of our tradition will only end in heaven. Here on earth, once we stop learning, we begin regressing, we slowly stop living when we stop learning.

There is a corollary to this first premise which I hope that you take to heart always, that is: FALL IN LOVE WITH GOD. We can only love God more when we get to know Him more. The reverse is equally true: we can't fall in love with someone we do not know. I usually give this advice to parents who would like to develop a spirituality in their children. I tell them to introduce their children to God and talk to them about what He does in their everyday lives, because in doing so, they begin to develop a personal encounter with Him, which will become a loving relationship.

Now let me explain what I mean when I say, "Fall in love with God."

- 1 TO FALL IS TO SURRENDER. When we think of "falling in love," we might immediately look at it from a romantic angle. However, here, I invite you to think more in terms of surrendering of oneself. To fall is to completely succumb to the weight of the earth. So when we fall in love with God, we completely surrender to Him.
- 2 THE CATCHER LOVED US FIRST. As we surrender to God, and fall in love with Him, our action of falling assures us by faith that God will catch us, and we fall gently in to His divine and holy arms. This is what we know about God especially in times of trials and tribulations. We never suffer alone; we are always suffering in the comforting arms of a provident and loving God. The Catcher loved us first, remember?
- 3 LOVE IS A CHOICE. The idea of "falling in love" might sound like it is not our choice to love, but I want to offer the image of choosing to "dive into" God's love as a better way to imagine what it is. We fall, not in the sense of tripping into something without our knowledge, but actually, making the conscious decision to "jump in" like that of someone on the edge of a helicopter who is going to do a free dive into open space.
- 4 TO LOVE IS TO LIVE. It is true that we live in this world to love, because that is the desire of God. He brings us into existence in this world so that we may love Him. God desires us, and He brought us into existence with the intention to love and be loved. The reverse is also perfectly true: to love is to live! God is love, and when we love God, we live abundantly. Falling then is not to end in destruction, but instead, we find our true self and live in the most beautiful and meaningful way possible. We become most alive when we are in love. That is true with every relationship, but most importantly, it is perfectly true in our relationship with God.

At the evening of life, says St. John of the Cross, we shall all be judged by how much we have loved. This is something that has guided me for many years in my discernment and introspection. I invite you, dear friends, to think about this often and keep it always in your hearts and minds: are you in love with God?






CMAA Pledge Report for Mary Queen of Heaven
