

#### A Message from Fr. Sunny

# Happy Easter. Mary Queen of Heaven!

What a privilege to share this most glorious Easter Sunday with all of you! I feel grateful that we are together in faith and that we can celebrate the gift of new life in Jesus Christ!

EASTER IS CALCULATED IN A SPECIFIC WAY. Every year, the Sunday of Easter changes. And from determining when Easter Sunday will be observed, we then determine when the Lenten Season begins, that is, Ash Wednesday. In 325 AD the Council of Nicaea decreed that Easter should be observed on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the spring equinox (March 21). Easter, therefore, can fall on any Sunday between March 22 and April 25.

KEEP A SEASON OF JOY. The Easter Season is a season of joy, a celebration of life that Jesus won for us. I call upon your creative minds to find ways to celebrate this season well. Find joy in the everyday graces that God showers you. Celebrate some little moments where you can recognize the goodness of God. They are everywhere and always available, but it takes a spiritual eye to recognize it. As Easter people, we need to ask daily: What blessings does God give me today? In every moment, we ask: Where is God here and now?

CELEBRATE OUR BELOVED DEAD. Because of Christ's resurrection, our dearly departed are safely home with the Lord, and the Suffering Church have hope to be released in God's mercy. And we who walk the militant journey have a chance to be united with our loved ones in the fullness of the Kingdom. I think of my grandfather, who was very special to my own childhood, and I give thanks to God for the gift of life that he has given to us all, one that only ends in a good ending, i.e., everlasting life, a happily ever after.

EASTER IS A SEASON. Some people who celebrate Easter think of it as a day. They go to church, celebrate with family, wear the Easter clothes, and maybe even eat the Easter meal. What we don't always think about is that Easter is a Season, and it lasts for fifty days, beginning from Easter Sunday and concludes in the celebration of Pentecost Sunday. It is good to celebrate all of Easter, because we are a Church of the Resurrection, Christians are Easter people.

REMEMBER: EVERY SUNDAY IS EASTER. As Christians, we now look to the first day of the week, Sunday, as the day of the Lord, because it is the day of the Resurrection. We celebrate mass every Sunday as the day of the Resurrection. How joyful indeed to be a Christian because Jesus is our victor. We are champions over sin and death, we are Sunday people, we are the Church of the Resurrection. Every Sunday, we gather for the victory feast, and receive the Eucharist of our triumphant Lord.

WORDS OF THANKS. I would like to thank our parishioners, volunteers, liturgical ministers, deacons, staff and everyone who made the Lenten and Holy Week liturgies very beautiful and special. May the Lord bless you a hundredfold for your devotion and generosity to our community. Without you, we would not be able to accomplish the goals we have set for the season. God bless you always. I WILL KEEP THESE BEAUTIFUL MEMORIES in my heart, wherever I may lead in my priestly story. Thank you, thank you, thank you.


