

A Message from Fr. Sunny

Jesus Forgives... Jesus Heals...

OUR PARISH MISSION 2024

When people come to a parish mission, most of the time, the experience is that of listening to a speaker who teaches about the faith or provides inspiration to the people to live out the Gospel and their Catholic Christian faith more boldly and passionately. That was the kind of eucharistic mission we offered last year. But not this year, our parish mission experience will allow more interaction and active participation. I will serve as the mission moderator and facilitator, but for the most part, those who will come are expected to put in some personal engagement.

DAY ONE. (Monday, March 18) JESUS FORGIVES. Over the years, including the past four years of my ministry here at Mary Queen, the topic of forgives seems to never become irrelevant. Every person, one way or the other, seems to need to receive or offer forgiveness, and in most cases, both. We begin the mission with a topic on forgiveness because this is a fundamental starting point of most spirituality. It is the disposition that makes us aware of our need of God, and to find peace within our hearts. We will look at unforgiveness as a wound that doesn't heal deep within us. We surrender it to the Lord and let His Divine Spirit teach our hearts to forgive.

DAY TWO. (Tuesday, March 19) JESUS HEALS. Forgiveness takes a new face in the idea of healing. Jesus brought healing to our broken world. Healing is so much more than a cure. It is God's gift of renewal of the entire person, a re-ordering of oneself, so that new life may be born through the suffering and pain. This second day of the mission will provide our participants with opportunities for silence, for shared prayers and conversations, and for writing your inner thoughts and feelings.

DAY THREE. (Wednesday, May 20) FORGIVENESS AND HEALING IN THE EUCHARIST. A holy mass will be celebrated, followed by the sacrament of anointing of the sick. We bring our wounds and pains to the Lord, because only He can truly make something lifegiving and joyful out of our sufferings and tribulations. The Lord Jesus gave us Himself in the Eucharist as a perfect reminder of His self-sacrifice, an offering of His Body and Blood so that we may find peace within ourselves. Jesus dwells and reigns within us when we receive Him as our Eucharist, and where Jesus dwells, there is our Divine Healer.

I personally invite you to share who you are and tell your story of healing and forgiveness. God wants us to use our own experiences of divine love to inspire and encourage others. We will never ever imagine the full impact of our story when Jesus uses it as a balm for healing others.


